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Instrumental Music

Students who have participated in Queensland State Schools Instrumental Music Program in primary school are eligible to continue in the Instrumental Music program in secondary school. Instrumental Music (IM) tuition is offered in Woodwind, Brass, Percussion and Strings and lessons take place during school hours.

The ensemble groups at Mackay State High School are the Concert Band, Symphonic Band, String Ensemble, Advanced String Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble and Big Band. Students will be allocated an ensemble at the beginning of the year and participation in the Symphonic Band and Big Band is based on merit (previous IM assessment results and audition). Performances in these ensemble groups take place throughout the year, showcasing the high standard of music excellence at Mackay State High School.

Feeder Primary School Connections

Students in the Creative Arts Academy will work closely with the feeder primary schools to help support the transition to high school and develop the Arts involvement between schools. Some opportunities for the Academy students to build the primary school connections include the Instrumental Music Primary School Mentorship Program and offers to participate in the Arts showcase events as guest performers and artists.
